Identify Yourself As A Competitor

All competitors must register in person at the Best Western Command Post Registration Center prior to their event. Please make every effort to register the day before your event (registration hours listed below). At registration, competitors are required to produce Law Enforcement/Fire Service photo identification card and shield. You may also be requested to show your ID at your event site. Individual registration packet and complimentary gifts can only be picked up by the individual registered competitor.

It is the competitors responsibility to check at the Command Post for competition changes.

ENTRY FEE (see example at the bottom Application page 2 of 2)

Competitors- Mail your application, waivers, and entry fee directly to, NYLEA, 3349 Monroe Av #182, Rochester, NY 14618. Make money order payable to NYLEA.

All amounts are quoted in UNITED STATES DOLLARS. The BASIC ENTRY FEE is \$50 USD. The EVENT FEE is the last three digits of the Event Code. Add event fees and basic fee for total fees payable.

A \$10.00 late registration fee will be required if postmarked after May 17. Registration forms postmarked after May 24 will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.

ROSTERS

- Each competitor must submit the two page registration form.
- Doubles teams must list partners name on registration form.
- Submit one sport roster per Team for each Team event.
- A team event is any event having three or more entrants competing together.
- Team Captains are responsible for submitting a team roster **along with individual applications from all members of the team.** Team members and coach must be listed. No entry fee is required for a non-playing Coach (see ELIGIBILITY).
- Incomplete rosters/registration forms will not be accepted.
- If a team plays with an ineligible competitor, that team will forfeit the game(s) played and be disqualified from the competition. **IF IN DOUBT, CONTACT US.**

ELIGIBILITY

- A competitor must be publicly employed or honorably retired as a Police/Peace Officer or Firefighter prior to the first day of competition.
- Coaches are eligible to receive medals, provided their application is submitted and entry fee paid.
- Civilian departmental employees may not compete.

AGE CATEGORIES

The following age categories apply:

Open29 & under	Super Master . .	.45 to 49
Senior30 to 34	Ultra Master . .	.50 to 54
Master35 to 39	Platinum55 and over
Golden Master .	.40 to 44	Classic-see Bowling	next page

At the beginning of an event, if 8 or more Platinum competitors are present and 4 or more are 60 years of age or older, an additional older age group will be added at the event site.

- Age is determined as of the first day of competition.
- Team members will compete at the age of the youngest team member.
- A competitor may only enter one age category in an event and may only have one partner in each sport.
- If the Code Sheet does not list age categories (eg: Senior, Master, etc.) for an event, that event is an OPEN event and will not be contested by age.

COMBINING DEPARTMENTS

- Police and Firefighters may not compete on the same team.
- Competitors combining to form teams (including doubles) must be from agencies that are either all Police or all Fire.
- If an agency enters a team, competitors from that agency may not combine with another agency to form additional team(s).
- In any other team or doubles event, competitors from agencies with less than 200 sworn personnel may combine with any other agency in their respective county.
- *NOTE: Female officers, from other than New York City PD, who are unable to form a team may combine with officers from Departments within their county or a contiguous county.
- If a team plays with an ineligible competitor, that team will forfeit the game(s) played and be disqualified from the competition.

**RETIRED: Retired Law Enforcement Officers/Firefighters, living within New York State, but outside of their area of employment, may compete as a member of a team representing their current county of residence or with his/her original employer (but not both). A valid drivers license is required to verify their place of residence. Applies to all events.

OUT OF STATE COMPETITORS

We welcome out of state competitors.

SUBSTITUTIONS

- Substitutes must register at the Command Post Hotel Registration Center.
- Substitutions must be made by the Department Coordinator or team captain. A completed entry form, signed waiver, and additional fees, if required, must be submitted to the Command Post Hotel Registration Center for each sub.
- All substitutes must meet the same requirements as the original entrants.
- Once competition has commenced in an event, substitutions cannot be made.
- Substitutions will not be made in individual events.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS FROM ONE DEPARTMENT

There are no limits as to the number of competitors who may compete from any Department, in any sport, unless otherwise stated in the sport rules, registration form or media releases. The Competition Review Board reserves the right to limit entrants at it's discretion.

SPORTS INFORMATION

BOWLING- SPARE TIME CLIFTON PARK

All competitors who win a medal (except for Open Division) must present their verification of average PRIOR to receiving their medal.

- To qualify for the CLASSIC DIVISION you must:
 - a. be 50 years of age or older at the time of the event
 - b. must NOT have won any bowling medals in the last two Police and Fire Games

There must be at least 15 Classic competitors in each of the Men Open or Men "A" categories. Their must be at least 10 Classic competitors in the Men "B", Women Open, or Women "A" categories. If there are not enough entries for a Classic Division, Classic competitors will revert to the non-classic division they entered. Classic competitors automatically qualify for the Classic All Events medals.

- All "A", "B", & Non-Open Classic bowlers must present a letter, on association letterhead, containing the following: Association secretary's name and phone number, names of all leagues, averages and number of games bowled in each league (must be at least 21 games), highest average at end of 2009/2010 season. Competitors who do not have this letter with them in Albany will be subject to forfeiture of medal/s. Any competitor who misrepresents his/her average will be subject to ban from future competitions.
- Competitors who won an "A" or "B" Gold medal two (2) years in a row must bowl in the next higher division.

GOLF-MEN

GOLFERS MUST PLAY IN OWN AGE GROUP OR AGE GROUP OF THE YOUNGEST PLAYER ON DOUBLES TEAM. The greens fee includes cart & lunch. Maximum of 152 golfers. All golfers must enter singles even if they only want to compete in the doubles event. \$155 greens fee payable in advance. The Club requires that we reserve the space/carts and guarantee the fees. Please list your handicap on the registration form for possible use in grouping foursomes. Practice rounds are at competitors expense. Course telephone- 518 438-2208.

HORSESHOES

Doubles will be held in the morning followed by Singles.

PISTOL

To guarantee a place on the line that matches your schedule, you must preregister with the enclosed squadding form. Course of fire and rules are available on our website.

RIFLE (LARGE BORE / SNIPER)

Pre-squadding prior to the Games is mandatory. The squadding form can be found on our website at www.nylea.org. If more than 30 shooters enter in each event, A & B Classes will be formed. Course of fire and rules are available on our website.

SKEET

Squadding will begin at 0800hrs. Shooting will start at 0900hrs.

SOCCER

Team fee of \$500. Team captains must submit a team roster, a check for \$500, and an individual registration form with both sides completed by **EACH** team member.

If a competitor is playing soccer and not entering additional events, then only the team fee of \$500 applies. Under these circumstances the basic fee of \$50 is waived. If a competitor enters additional sports the competitor must also pay the \$50 basic fee and event fees, in addition to a portion of the team fee. Any questions, please contact NYLEA.
